## **POSITION OVERVIEW**

The City Engineer for the City of League City is a department head level position that will be responsible for the capital improvement program, traffic engineering and development services. This department has an annual operating budget of approximately two million and an annual capital improvement expenditure approaching \$50 million.

The position reports directly to the Director of Public Works. Responsibilities include development and implementation of the city's five-year capital improvement program (facilities, parks and public infrastructure), capital recovery fee analysis, selected grant applications/administration, negotiation and implementation of development agreements, inspection of public/private infrastructure, and traffic engineering.

## **CANDIDATE PROFILE**

The ideal candidate for this position must possess a strong and vast knowledge of engineering and construction methods and management that are applicable to public infrastructure, park improvement and facilities. Extensive knowledge is needed in local, state and federal codes, ordinances and regulations. The ability to build and maintain positive relationships with associates, contractors, developers, elected officials, and the general public is required.

## **POSITION REQUIREMENTS**

A Bachelor's Degree in Engineering with seven to ten years of experience as an engineer in a Public Works Department or related department is required. Applicants must also be a registered professional engineer with the ability to become registered in the State of Texas within six months of employment.

The City of League City will establish a salary that is dependent upon the candidate's qualifications and experience. The City participates in the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS) at a 7% employee deposit rate with a municipal matching ratio of 2:1. A full range of leave and insurance benefits is also provided.

## CITY ORGANIZATION

The City of League City operates under a Council-Manager form of government. The City Council is comprised of a Mayor and seven Council Members, all elected at-large, for four-year terms. The City Council appoints a professional City Manager to lead and manage the day-to-day operations of the organization. Other positions appointed by the City Council include the City Attorney, City Secretary, City Auditor, and Municipal Court Judges.

## THE COMMUNITY

The City consists of a fully staffed Police Department, Volunteer Fire Department and EMS. The City also provides services including water, wastewater, parks and cultural services, public works, finance and utility billing, information technology, human resources, communications, and planning and development.

Settled in 1873 by George W. Butler, the City of League City, was originally known as Butler's Ranch or Clear Creek until 1893, when J.C. League acquired the land and laid out the town site on the Galveston, Houston, and Henderson Railroad, which had been built through the area in 1854.

League City, population of more than 102,000 is one of the fastest growing cities within the region and is



the largest city in Galveston County. It is strategically located between the Ports of Houston, Texas City, Galveston, and Freeport and the nation's fourth busiest cruise terminal. The City is well-known for its recreational lifestyle, outstanding quality of life, beautiful neighborhoods, excellent school systems, an abundance of parks, historic homes, museums, and tremendous waterfront oasis.

League City regularly ranks among the best communities in the country, and was named one of the Best Small Cities in America by Money Magazine and one of the top 10 Smartest Cities in Texas by the Business Journal's On Numbers. Additionally, Bay Area Magazine named League City as the Best Place to Live and home to the Best Fire and Police Departments in 2011.

Three airports conveniently serve League City including William P. Hobby, George Bush Intercontinental Airport and Ellington Field (which is used by NASA and private operators). Union Pacific Railroad also operates a main line through the community that frequently transports goods throughout the Midwest, southeast and west coast. League City is also strategically located 23 miles from the Port of Houston.

League City distinguishes itself within the region demographically with household income levels and education profiles well above the average for the surrounding area.

Home to the third largest concentration of pleasure boats in the United States, League City, is a great destination for year-round visitors who are looking for a wide variety of entertainment, eateries, cultural, and recreational activities.
