This recreational program is designed for boys and girls ages 3 and 4. The program offers children an opportunity to develop social skills and team play while having fun.

Rookie Ball

This recreational program is designed for boys and girls ages 5 and 6. This stage in recreational baseball helps boys and girls develop techniques in hitting, fielding, throwing and base running.

Coach Pitch

This recreational program is designed for boys and girls ages 7-9. This stage in recreational baseball helps boys and girls emphasize techniques in hitting, fielding, throwing and base running in a modified game play.

- Glove, bats, helmets, pants/shorts, socks & shoes will not be provided...most teams will decide on a style of pants
